Disabled Student Support

Kobe University provides disabled students with the support required at the time of the entrance examination and admission to the University as well as during the post-admission period, through each faculty/school/graduate school and Student Affairs Department.

1. Support at the Time of the Entrance Exam

Disabled applicants who need special care and support when taking the entrance examination and during their studies after being admitted to the University are requested to consult the entrance examination section of the relevant faculty/school/graduate school.

2. Post-Admission Support

Kobe University aims to provide disabled students with parking space on the campus and create an environment that will enable them to move around and carry out their various activities on the campus more easily, according to the type of disability and individual needs.

Each faculty/school/graduate school of the University also aims to establish an adequate learning support system by conducting classes in classrooms that are accessible to disabled students, securing appropriate seating for them, and providing in-class support.
